APEX MINING PASIG EMPLOYEES FULLY VACCINATED THROUGH ICTSI INITIATIVE

Also extending vaccine support to host communities

The employees of Apex Mining Co. Inc. stationed at its head office in Pasig are now fully vaccinated against COVID-19 through the inoculation drive of the International Container Terminal Services, Inc. (ICTSI).

Its Maco Mine in Davao de Oro plus its subsidiaries, Itogon-Suyoc Resources, Inc (ISRI) in Benguet and Paracale Gold Ltd. in Camarines Norte are also gearing up for



their inoculation drives. Each APX employee is also entitled to two (2) full doses for two (2) dependents, free of charge. APX is giving doses to its consultants and contractors' site employees, as well.

The vaccination initiative of APX is a manifestation of its commitment to the uniquely Filipino value of *malasakit*. As APX's President and CEO Luis R Sarmiento emphasized in his report at the Annual Stockholders' Meeting in June this year, one of the lessons of the COVID pandemic is the importance of working together for the good of all.
