NETWORK TO CELEBRATE MANDELA DAY

APX, 24 July 2023 — Apex Mining and the Philippine Mine Safety and Environment Association (PMSEA), together with the Embassy of South Africa and GMA Network, treated 20 seniors under the auspices of Project Pearls to a delicious buffet lunch (at the posh Admiral Hotel, no less!) and soothing song numbers from GMA Sparkle artists Gaea Mischa and Muriel Lomodilla.
