Jose Eduardo J. Alarilla, Chairman of the Board

Jose Eduardo J. Alarilla assumed chairmanship of the Board of Directors of Apex Mining in September 2021. Mr. Alarilla holds key positions in other companies: Chairman of Mega Equipment International Corp.; Vice Chairman of Bloomberry Resorts Corporation, a publicly listed company; President and CEO of Mega Subic Terminal Services, Inc.; and, President of Manila Holdings and Management, Inc., LVHI, DEI, Eiffle House, Inc., Alpha Allied Holdings Ltd., and Sureste Properties, Inc. He is also a Director of Bloomberry Resorts and Hotels, Inc., MORE, and International Cleanvironment Systems, Inc. Mr. Alarilla holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from De La Salle University and a master's degree in business management from the Asian Institute of Management.

Luis R. Sarmiento, ASEAN Eng., Director; President & CEO

Luis R. Sarmiento, ASEAN Eng. was elected as President & CEO of the Parent Company on 28 June 2019 (he was also elected as President of ISRI and MORE on the same day). He was appointed Senior EVP & COO on 01 October 2018.

Prior to joining Apex Mining, Mr. Sarmiento was the president of Orica Explosives Philippines, Inc., a global publicly listed mining services company headquartered in Melbourne, Australia. He served Orica in various capacities for 34 years, rising from the ranks to become its highest-ranking Filipino officer.

Mr. Sarmiento is also the president of the Philippine Mine Safety and Environment Association (PMSEA), an organization dedicated to furthering responsible mining through exemplary environment and safety practices. He first served as PMSEA's president from 2008 to 2017.
